C.	<ul> <li>PET RULES: Tenant must:</li> <li>(1) take all reasonable action to insure that any pet does not violate the rights of other persons;</li> <li>(2) comply with all applicable statutes, ordinances, restrictions, owners' association rules, and other enforceable regulations regarding any pet;</li> <li>(3) keep the rabies shots of any pet current;</li> <li>(4) confine any pet that is a dog or cat, when outside, by fences or on leashes under Tenant's control;</li> <li>(5) confine any pet other than a dog or cat in appropriate cages at all times;</li> <li>(6) promptly remove any pet waste from the Property, including all living areas, garages, storage areas, yard porches, patios, courtyards, and decks; and</li> <li>(7) promptly remove from the Property any offspring of any pet.</li> </ul>						
D.	ACCESS: Tenant must remove or confine any pet at any time that the pet is likely to limit or prohibit Landlord or other persons access to Property as permitted by the lease.

INDEMNIFICATION: <u>Tenant will protect</u> , <u>defend</u> , <u>indemnify</u> , <u>and hold Landlord</u> , <u>Landlord</u> 's <u>property manager</u> , <u>Landlord</u> 's <u>agents harmless from any damages</u> , <u>costs</u> , <u>attorney</u> 's <u>fees</u> , <u>and expenses that are caused by the act of pet or Tenant</u> .					
Н.	. <b>DEFAULT:</b> If Tenant breaches any provision in this pet agreement, Landlord may exercise all or any of the remedie described under Paragraph 9B of the lease.					
I. SPECIAL PROVISIONS: Pitbulls, snakes, pot-bellied pigs and lizards of any kind are strict prohibited. If any portion of the pet deposit is refundable to tenant, it will no issued any sooner than 30 days after tenant has vacated the unit and all keys to landlord. Depending on the condition of the unit at move-charge for cleaning and disinfecting the unit WILL be deducted from the deposit.
